Hondaline helmets are constructed of laminated fiberglass, bonded into a solid, one-piece shell. They passed the tough Snell test with flying colors. Talk about colors. Hondaline helmets are possibly the best looking helmets around. Some are even color-coordinated to Honda motorcycles. Inside, they're cushioned for snugness, comfort and shock absorption.

Hondaline jerseys are made of 100% nylon mesh. They're lightweight and tough, with double layers of nylon at the shoulders and elbows for extra protection. You can get them in several colors, with or without the trademark "Honda."

Hondaline shirts are long-sleeved, double-knit nylon numbers with reinforced elbows for extra wearability and protection. Hondaline shirts bear the trademark "Honda" on the chest and are

available in a variety of exciting color combinations.

Wear-anywhere jackets.

Hondaline jackets are so good-looking you'll want to wear them even when you're not riding. Our jackets are full cut, with elasticized waistbands and wind flaps under the zippers. Choose from two styles in four colors; two with Scotchlite™ safety stripes and two in metallic gold or silver. All of them feature stretchable, snug-fitting cuffs, zippered side pockets; some styles include Velcro collars and expandable "action" backs.

For cold weather riding, you can add an optional liner to Hondaline jackets. These liners are quilted for comfort, with four layers of material for warmth.

As for gloves, it's what we took out of them that makes them outstanding. The palms are seamless, which means there's a lot less chance you'll get blisters, no matter how long you wear them. Palms are made strictly from quality-grain cowhide; backs are handsome split cowhide.

Hondaline in-the-boot leathers are tailored only in quality-grain cowhide.

Inside, the linings are nylon for comfort, with full padding at the knee and hip, plus an extra layer of leather at the thigh and seat area. Leg zippers are heavy-duty brass; belt loops are large and strong. You'll agree our new leathers look and feel great. And great

to have on in dirt country!

Two styles of boots.

Hondaline boots are rugged, comfortable and good-looking. You can choose from lace or buckle types. The buckle style features thickly padded, water-resistant, knee-high shin guards. Plus double nylon stitching at major stress points. And hard box safety toes, spring steel arch supports, cushioned insoles. There's extra padding at ankle and collar areas. And soles are oil-resistant. Lace-style Hondaline boots retain most of the major features, but are somewhat lower in cost.
