**MR-50** For the mini-moto fan, Honda has a special price on the Elsinore-styled '74 model MR-50. Now only \$256 (\$261 East Coast price). This red racer sports a hot 49cc two-stroke engine coupled to a three-speed transmission. The MR-50 is designed just to fit the younger rider. Controls are easy to operate by smaller hands and feet. Handlebars and seat height are perfect for the junior motocrosser to power into turns, and get up on the pegs in the tough sections. Other features include shielded air cleaner, Honda spark arrestor/muffler, knobby tires, free-valve telescopic front forks and a racing oval number plate. There's also a four-position throttle stop so parents can adjust top speed output to the capabilities of their mini-racer. Remember, this little MR-50 powerhouse is now only \$256\*.
